3. Governing Body Resolutions

IADT has received confirmation of the three Ministerial Nominees nominated by the Minister for FHERIS, for appointment to the IADT Governing Body. A short bio for each nominee was circulated. It was confirmed that the three Ministerial Nominees have been considered and approved by the Governing Body Nominations Committee, and are recommended by the Nominations Committee to the Governing Body for approval.

Resolution 20/2023 was adopted by the Governing Body.

The Governing Body noted that receipt of confirmation of the three Ministerial Nominees to the Governing Body has been outstanding over the past year, and welcomed that the matter has now been brought to a conclusion. The Governing Body is now at full membership, providing the additional expertise which will benefit the Institute. In addition it will now be possible to bring the membership of Sub Committees of Governing Body to their full levels which will positively impact on the efficient working of these committees. The ministerial Nominees to Governing Body have been appointed for a 4-year term of office. There are now a number of staggered completion dates on which members of the Governing Body will complete their term of office, which will result in a greater level of continuity for the Institute.

- Following the appointment of the three Ministerial Nominees, it was confirmed that the gender balance of the Governing Body has been maintained.
- Additional members will be proposed for appointment to the Sub Committees of Governing Bodies which will enable these committees to maintain a gender balance within their memberships.
